VACCINATION STATUS CHANGE

The Sport Yukon board of directors has decided that a declaration of vaccination status is not needed to participate in the Klondike Road Relay.

The decision was made after reviewing other sporting events that are happening in the Yukon and the change in requirements by the Yukon Government.

At the time of the race, runners, volunteers, and support teams will need to comply with the current border mandates regarding vaccines and entry into Canada and the United States.

Currently, the requirement to cross the border is double vaccination but that may change. It is the responsibility of the participant to meet all the standards of crossing the borders.
