## DECISION DATES

On March 31, Sport Yukon's board will make a decision about the 2022 Klondike Road Relay in regards to whether Plan A or Plan B will be used. Plan A remains to run the historical route from Skagway to Whitehorse, with our American friends.



## START LOCATIONS

Teams in the Plan B Klondike Road Relay will begin the race at Leg 4 and follow the traditional route into Rotary Park in Whitehorse. Youth, walkers and solo teams will be starting from Carcross and work their way to the finish.

## REGISTRATION

For the KRR to go ahead, at minimum, 800 racers will need to register – regardless if its Plan A or Plan B. Other details are still in the works so stay tuned. We are hoping we can rely on your support to make this happen!

## KRR Plan B

2022's race was supposed to mark the KRR's 40th anniversary which is huge for us. However, because we want to celebrate it properly, we will wait until 2023 to do so. 2022's race will be dubbed KRR 39.5.

So, given the present uncertain times it was necessary to hash-out a Plan B in case COVID-19 remains unforgiving.

The good news with Plan B, is it inches the race closer to its historical form. In 2021, the race started from Leg 6, in 2022, the race will begin from the Canadian side of the border (Leg 4). Plan B was made based on the input from the race community.
